PIVOT

HIGH YIELD POTENTIAL • STANDS STRONG • UNIFORM

Pivot is a medium-early maturing, short, semi-dwarf hard red spring wheat with very strong tillering capacity. It was bred for high yield environments with plenty of moisture. It is perfect for irrigated production. Pivot produces medium protein grain with medium to low test weight. Pivot is moderately susceptible to stem rust, moderately resistant to leaf rust and foliar disease (tan spot and Septoria), and susceptible to scab and stripe rust.

MANAGEMENT STRATEGY

1. Pivot is a medium-early maturity variety that responds to early planting but can be planted on any reasonable planting date.
2. Plant Pivot at normal populations for your area.
3. Fertilize Pivot for a yield of about 80 to 100 bu (2.5 lbs of N/bushel of yield to reach 14% protein). Make sure that Sulfur levels are in balance with Nitrogen; 5N:1S in the soil and 10N:1S in plant tissue is recommended.
4. Provide an early (4-5 leaf stage) fungicide treatment.
5. Provide a precisely timed fungicide treatment at heading to control scab.
6. Harvest in a timely fashion to prevent secondary scab infestation.
